

Tasting notes and press

Made in a "classic" style, part of the wine was aged during eight months in French oak barrels. Is recommended to use a decanter during the year 2023.

The Cabernet Sauvignon vineyard "Las Casas" had a report on the oldest vines in the world at jancisrobinson.com in August 2022 and the 2019 Kodkod vintage achieved 17.5/20 "A very pure, ripe, sweet, minted-blackcurrant nose. Striking purity of fruit on the palate. And striking elegance built into the long-limbed, cool, herb-scented tannins".

The 2019, 2021 and 2022 vintages (for 2020 we did not make this wine) have achieved scores of 94/100 at "Descorchados", probably the most prestigious Chilean critic.

Grape Varieties

85% Cabernet Sauvignon: The "Las Casas" vineyard was established at least the year 1900 according to official records and has never been grafted. 10% Carménère and 5% Syrah create complexity. Handpicked on March 16th.

Apellation

The vineyards are planted on gentle slopes of the hills of the Coastal Range. About one kilometer away from the Maule River.

Winemaking and History

Santa Rosa de Lavaderos is in a valley protected by the first hills of the Coastal Mountain Range, the rivers Maule and Loncomilla. In these hills, the family that owns the farm has a natural reservation of native forest, where among other vulnerable species dwells the Kodkod (the smallest wild cat of the world).
